COLLECTIVELY, THE ENTRIES PULL THE READER INTO THE LIVES OF ORDINARY AMERICANS, WHILE SECTION INTRODUCTIONS TIE TOGETHER THE ENTRIES AND PROVIDE AN OVERARCHING NARRATIVE THAT PRIMES READERS TO UNDERSTAND KEY CONCEPTS ABOUT ANTEBELLUM AMERICA BEFORE DELVING INTO AMERICANS' LIVES IN DETAIL.
